Theme: Loudoun Streams—Keep 'em Clean

Poster, Prose and Photography Contest Guidelines

The contest is open to all Loudoun County students in grades K–12 (public, private and home-school). The objective of the contest is to create an entry that characterizes the theme: *Loudoun Streams—Keep 'em Clean*.

Posters should not be larger than 11" x 17". Essays and poems can be hand printed or typed, and must fit on one page 8-1/2" x 11" (standard letter size). Photos may be standard or digital format, black and white or color and no larger than 8"x10". You can submit entries by email to lyoung@loudounwater.org

All entries become the property of the sponsors and may be used at their discretion. The sponsors reserve the right to alter a poster's design for printing purposes. Original entries will be returned to students.
